

## More Troubling Facts about Kevin Jennings

- The Obama administration appointed Kevin Jennings to a senior staff position in the U.S. Department of Education.
- As the head of the Office of Safe and Drug-Free Schools, he controls federal funds that influence curriculum and school programs. This is disturbing because Jennings has a long track record of twisting the word “safety” into homosexual activism.
- That track record is well-documented by his 17-year career as the founder and leader of GLSEN—the Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network.
- GLSEN is the nation’s largest advocacy group dedicated to promoting homosexuality to public school kids all the way down to kindergarten level.
- As GLSEN’s leader, Jennings wrote the foreword to a book called *Queering Elementary Education*. Chapters titles include, “Locating a Place for Gay and Lesbian Themes in Elementary ...” and “‘It’s Okay to be Gay’: Interrupting Straight Thinking in the English Classroom.”
- Under Jennings leadership, GLSEN crafted a 24-page booklet (*Just the Facts*) that was sent to some 16,000 school officials nationwide. Among other things, the booklet tells schools that “experimentation and discovery” are “common” for youth. To learn more, [click here](#).
- Jennings advocates overt indoctrination. He recommends a “questionnaire” for students in his book, *Becoming Visible*. Question No. 5: “If you have never slept with someone of the same sex, how do you know you wouldn’t prefer that? Is it possible you merely need a good gay experience?”
- A similar “Heterosexual Questionnaire” appears in a GLSEN resource for educators. This resource is promoted as a way to expose “heterosexism” and “make schools safer places.” To learn more [click here](#).
- *We can’t allow Jennings to use taxpayer money to push indoctrination tools like this into our nation’s classrooms in the name of “safe schools.”*
- Jennings’ book *Becoming Visible* also includes lessons on Harry Hay—a man who promoted the North American Association for Man-Boy Love Association (NAMBLA), which wants to eliminate age-of-consent laws.
- What’s especially frightening about Jennings’ appointment to the “safe schools” office, is that he has publicly stated his intent to use the word “safety” as a “calling card” to promote GLSEN’s goals. - Likewise, GLSEN has used the “safe school” mantra to push its homosexual activism into classrooms.
  - GLSEN sponsors homosexuality-celebration events like the *Day of Silence* and *TransAction! Day* in thousands of schools.
  - *TransAction! Day* celebrates transgender and cross-dressing behavior. During this event, GLSEN encourages kids to practice using “gender-neutral” pronouns—such as “zie” instead of “he”—and to “launch a campaign to create a gender-neutral, all-genders or multi-gendered bathroom at your school.”
  - GLSEN makes available a “How to Get What You Want” instruction sheet to students who celebrate the *Day of Silence*, encouraging them to lobby for a “queer-friendly prom” and hand out cards advocating pro-gay state legislation. To learn more, [click here](#).
  - GLSEN wants gay, lesbian and transgender themes to be “fully integrated into curricula across a variety of subject areas and grade levels” (GLSEN Jump Start Guide-Part 5/ “Ten Things Educators Can Do”).
