

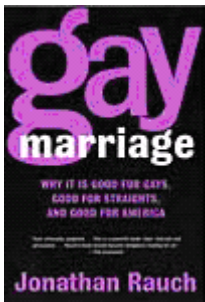
BOOK DONATION COMPARISON CHART

When asking the public library to accept your book donations, it's a good idea to cite the American Library Association's own statements calling for a diversity of viewpoints to be represented, including those that are "unorthodox or unpopular." 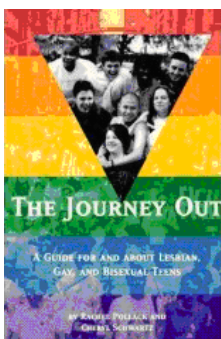

"The full social benefits of gay marriage will come when religions as well as governments customarily bless it: when women marry women in big church ceremonies as parents weep..."

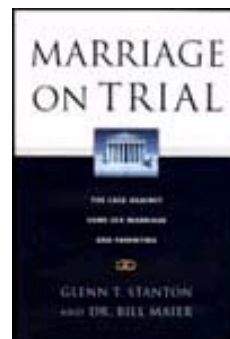
